2 - Don't Overload with Details: Too many instructions can confuse the response. Break your query into manageable parts.

- **Example:** Instead of asking for a full book outline in one go, request chapter-by-chapter ideas.

3 - Avoid Ambiguity in Style Requests: Clearly specify the tone or audience.

- Instead of: "Write something about AI."
- Try: "Explain AI's impact on education in an engaging, conversational tone."

4 - Don't Assume Context: Always clarify your intent or background needs.

- Instead of: "What's the best advice for me?"
- Try: "What's the best advice for a first-time entrepreneur starting an e-commerce business?"

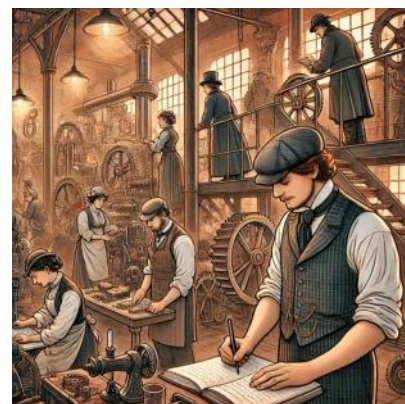

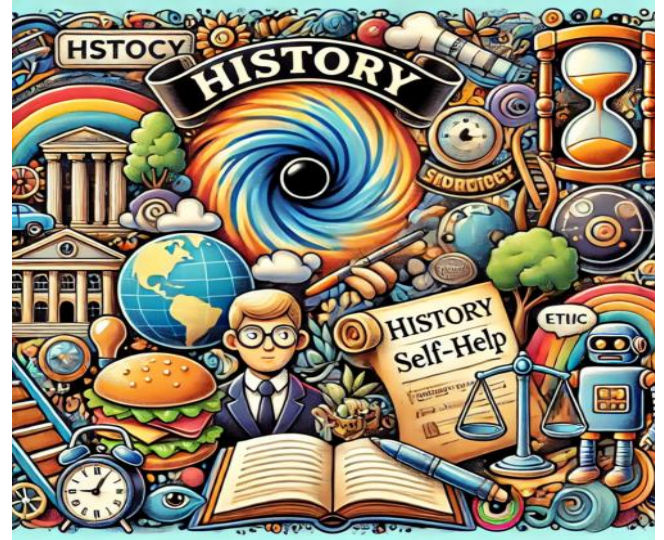
